



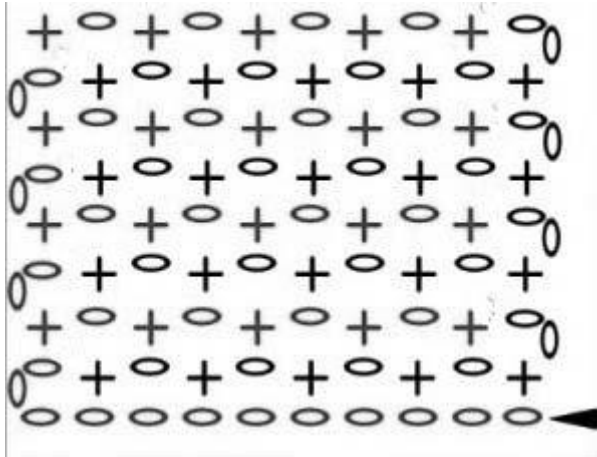
## What do you need to crochet this project?

- Crochet hook size 2.5 mm
- Yarn:
  - yardage: 1.76 Oz (50g) / 185 Yrds (169m)
  - weight: Fingering (14 wpi) / Super Fine
  - fiber type: 100% mercerized cotton

## Stitch abbreviations used in this crochet pattern

- ch - [chain](#)
- sc - [single crochet](#)

## Pattern



## Written instructions

Foundation chain: multiples of 2+1

Row 1: 2 ch, skip 3 ch from the hook, sc in next ch, \*ch, sc in next ch, rep from \* to the end, turn.

Row 2: 2 ch, sc in ch, \*ch, sc in ch, rep from \* to the end, turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have reached your desired length.
